

General data protection regulation

Introduction

As of the 25th of May 2018 the General data protection Regulation (**GDPR**) becomes law. This is a new European privacy law.

As a result, the privacy in all countries of the EU is the same.

In the **GDPR** compulsory measures are taken to protect a client's private and personal information. All therapists who store the personal data of a client must conform to the regulations set out in the **GDPR**.

If you contact me via this website or via email the following personal data are processed by me: -

Personal data

all the information that you want to share with me via email.

- Name and email address
- personal information that you want to share with me, for example: about your health, your date of birth, postal code, city, phone number etc.

Digital information you want to share with me is kept in digital format for maximal 1 year.

If you choose to become patient, there is the possibility that the information that you have sent me will be printed and added to your personal dossier.
